Part II: List of principal events leading to the litigation

Date	Event
1 June 2017	The Local Court of the Northern Territory at Katherine makes a Domestic Violence Order (the DVO) naming the appellant, Aileen Roy as the defendant and Toby Johnson as the protected person (CAB 58).
6 April 2018	Constable James Elliot, Constable Alexander Dowie and Sergeant Jackson Evans attend the appellant's premises and require her to submit to a breath test. The appellant is arrested for a contravention of the DVO and taken to the Katherine Watch House (CAB 59-60).
11 April 2018	The appellant is charged with a contravention of the DVO contrary to s 120(1) <i>Domestic and Family Violence Act 2007</i> (NT) (CAB 4).
13 November 2018	A contested summary hearing of the charge proceeds in the Local Court of the Northern Territory at Katherine (CAB 60).
16 November 2018	The appellant is found not guilty (CAB 10).

29 March 2019	Appeal hearing before Mildren AJ in the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory (CAB 61).
12 April 2019	Decision of Mildren AJ in the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory (CAB 14).
30 August 2019	Appeal hearing before Southwood and Kelly JJ and Riley AJ in the Court of Appeal of the Northern Territory (CAB 56).
4 September 2019	Decision of Southwood and Kelly JJ and Riley AJ in the Court of Appeal of the Northern Territory (CAB 55).
20 March 2020	Special leave granted by Bell, Gordon and Edelman JJ in the High Court of Australia (CAB 84).
