4.	18.06.2011	After 6.30pm	Steven Drover and Doug Webb arrived at the Hogarth Road house.	
5.	18.06.2011	7pm	At around this time, Leon Karpany and Natasha Fidler arrived at the Hogarth Road house.	
6.	18.06.2011	10pm – 10.30pm	The boxing tournament concludes.  Sumner shakes hands with Fitzgerald to say goodbye.  Sumner drops his cousin at a petrol station on Churchill Road, before being dropped himself at the Hogarth Road House, where he finds his family and friends sitting in the kitchen.	
7.	18.06.2011	10.30- 11pm	At the house, Sumner spends most of his time in the kitchen, toilet, bathroom and out the back.  In the kitchen, Sumner sits on the freezer, because there were not enough chairs.	
8.	18.06.2011		Sumner 'spars' and play fights with the deceased in the kitchen. The deceased tells Sumner to stop and goes to have a sleep in another room.	
9.	8.06.2011	Around 2am	Sumner goes out the front of the house and has an altercation with a group of girls parked in two cars further down Hogarth Road.  Sumner drags one of the girls by the hair and kicks the car windscreen in.	
10.	18.06.2011		Sumner returns inside to the kitchen and resumes sparring with the	

		deceased. Sumner pushes the deceased into the kitchen wall, leaving a hole.
