23 May 2013	Proceedings commenced by the Director, Fair Work Building Industry Inspectorate (the <b>Director</b> ) against the Appellantsin the Brisbane Registry of the Federal Court of Australia, alleging contraventions of the BCII Act.
29 November 2013	Statement of Agreed Facts filed in the proceeding by the Director and Appellants, setting out the facts agreed for the purpose of disposing of the proceeding, and the agreed sum of pecuniary penalties that the parties jointly sought that the Court impose upon the Appellants.
10 April 2014	Direction given by Chief Justice Allsop, pursuant to s 20(1A) of the <i>Federal Court of Australia Act 1976</i> (Cth), that the original jurisdiction of the Court in relation to the whole of the proceeding be exercised by a Full Court.
16 May 2014	Orders made by Justice Dowsett, granting leave to the Commonwealth to intervene in the proceedings before the Full Court, to be heard on issues relating to the application of <i>Barbaro v The Queen</i> (2014) 88 ALJR 372.
7 July 2014	Orders made by Justice Dowsett, granting leave to counsel engaged by the Commonwealth to appear at the hearing before the Full Court as contradictor on issues relating to the application of <i>Barbaro v The Queen</i> (2014) 88 ALJR 372.
11-12 August 2014	Hearing before the Full Court in Brisbane Registry.
